
Learn About Natural Gas Alarms

What do Natural Gas Alarms do?

Natural gas alarms detect gas leaks. Similar to smoke alarms that alert you to a fire or carbon monoxide alarms, natural gas alarms are an essential safety piece to a home that uses natural gas.


Natural gas is lighter than air, so if there is a gas leak, the natural gas will rise towards the ceiling. That is why it is important to place a natural gas alarm near the ceiling, so it can detect gas early. Gas alarms should be placed 12 inches from the ceiling and between 3-10 feet horizontally from a gas appliance.









1 - red | 2 - orange | 3 - yellow | 4 - green 5 - light blue | 6 - dark blue | 7 - gray | 8 - brown
